



## 2009 Adopt a Beach Cleanup at Coffee Creek Park September 19, 2009 Results Report



Fifteen volunteers collected trash at the park along the boardwalk, the bank of Coffee Creek, and other areas of the park.

Seventy-four pounds of trash was collected. Following is a summary of that trash:

- \* 12 Beverage Bottles (Plastic)
- \* 11 lbs of Broken Auto Glass
- \* 9 Glass Beverage Bottles
- \* 8 Caps/Lids
- \* 8 Tobacco Packaging/Wrappers
- \* 6 Building Materials
- \* 5 Straw/Stirrers
- \* 4 Cups, Plates, Forks, Knives, Spoons
- \* 4 Bait Containers/Packaging
- \* 2 Ropes
- \* 2 Toys
- \* 1 Fishing Lure/Light Stick
- \* 1 Building Material
- \* 1 Aerosol Can
- \* 1 Oil/Lube Bottle
- \* 1 Piece of Clothing/Shoes
- \* 1 Pull Tab
- \* 1 Plastic Sheeting/Tarps
- \* 1 Sheet of Plexiglass (broken)

\*Twenty-seven pounds of food stuff contained in several plastic ziplock baggies was found dumped in a secluded area of the park.

Storm water educational materials were disseminated to all of the volunteers.
