The meeting was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

By unanimous vote of the Commission, the motion was passed.

Chief Cincoski provided the Commission with a brief summary of the contents of the 2018 annual report and advised that it would be placed on the agenda for the March meeting for questions or discussion


