

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 08**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CHESTERTON TOWN COUNCIL  
AMENDING ITS TOWN CODE**

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Chesterton Town Council as follows:

**Section 1:** That on January 26, 2015, the Chesterton Town Council, through Ordinance 2015-01, amended Section 5-33 of the Chesterton Town Code by adopting a new document entitled “Chesterton Town Standards”, which now constitutes the minimum standards for municipal improvements in the Town of Chesterton.

**Section 2:** That Part C.4 – Composite Asphalt Pavement and Aggregate Base shall be amended to hereafter read as follows:

**(4) Composite Asphalt Pavement and Aggregate Base.**

**(a) Composite HMA – Local Streets.**

The minimum pavement design shall be one and one-half (1 ½) inches of Bituminous Surface on four (4) inches of Bituminous Binder on twelve (12) inches of Compacted Aggregate Limestone Base INDOT No. 53. If slag is utilized as aggregate base it must be supplied by an INDOT Certified Aggregate Producer Program Company with the slag meeting Indiana Test Method 212.00.

**(b) Composite HMA – Local Collector Streets, Local Arterial Streets, and non-residential Streets.**

The minimum pavement design shall be one and one-half (1 ½) inches of Bituminous Surface on four (4) inches of Bituminous Binder on four (4) inches of Bituminous Base on twelve (12) inches of Compacted Aggregate Limestone Base INDOT No. 53. If slag is utilized as aggregate base it must be supplied by an INDOT Certified Aggregate Producer Program Company with the slag meeting Indiana Test Method 212.00

**(c) Composite HMA - Construction Materials and Methods**


HMA pavement and Compacted Aggregate shall conform to the latest edition of INDOT Standard Specifications 301, 302, 303, 304, 305, 401, and 402, latest edition of INDOT Standard Drawings, and latest edition of the INDOT Design Manual.


**Section 3:** Any violation of the Chesterton Town Standards adopted herein shall subject the offender to the general penalty provisions of the Town Code found at Section 1-9. Every day any violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense

**Section 4:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.


