REPORTS

MS 4 PROGRAM REPORT – Town Engineer Mark O’Dell said last month they worked with Easton Park on drainage problems and came up with some solutions to help stop water from running onto the street. In Springdale, the pavement is down and they will be looking to get their secondary plat signed by the Town. Also, the storm sewer across the street needs adjusted. Engineer O’Dell went on to discuss that the Town is reviewing construction drawings in coffee creek subdivision for 6 new lots and this will go to plan commission.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT – Town Engineer M. O’Dell discussed the recent funds transfer to Trust IN. This information has been added to the financial sheet. Interest will be

added each month at a rate to be verified by Clerk-Treasurer C. Udvaré. The \$500,000 deposit that can be seen is a withdrawal from funds 254 and 54. Otherwise, for the month of May, a deficit of \$4,406 was ran.

OLD BUSINESS

CR 1050 Ditch—Town Engineer M. O’Dell said this will be worked on soon.

23rd Street Storm Sewer—Street Commissioner J. Schnadenberg explained that the issues with the 23rd Street storm sewer have been a challenge. Commissioner Schnadenberg said it took over a week to pump it out and that a lot of drainage goes to the area. Ground water was so high that they had to put in well points to repair pipe. Three days were spent getting the dirt out of the line. There is still work to do down there and they will have to bypass pump for 2 weeks. More camera work will be done soon. A report will be given again next month. Engineer O’Dell mentioned a lot of help was provided by the Fire Department and the Utility Department. Commissioner Schnadenberg also explained they are still getting street sweeping done and that they want to do the whole town by July 4th. Member V. Wittig mentioned that she had placed a call to the Town to let them know that the storm sewer adjacent to her property was collapsing. Commissioner Schnadenberg said the issue will be looked into.
